

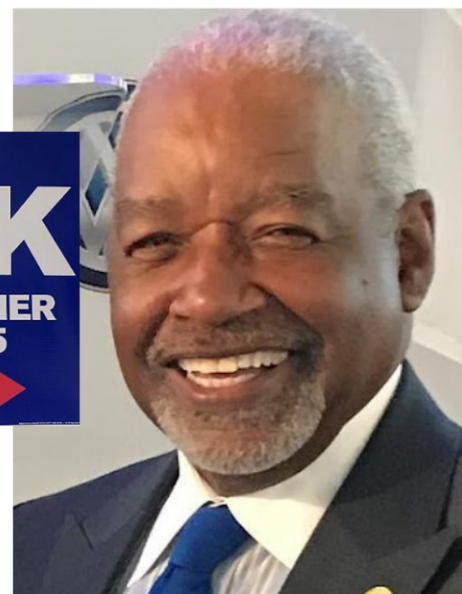
# LET'S RE-ELECT GREG BECK COUNTY COMMISSIONER DISTRICT 5
