Pastor Hathaway's Anniversary to be Celebrated at Greater Tucker

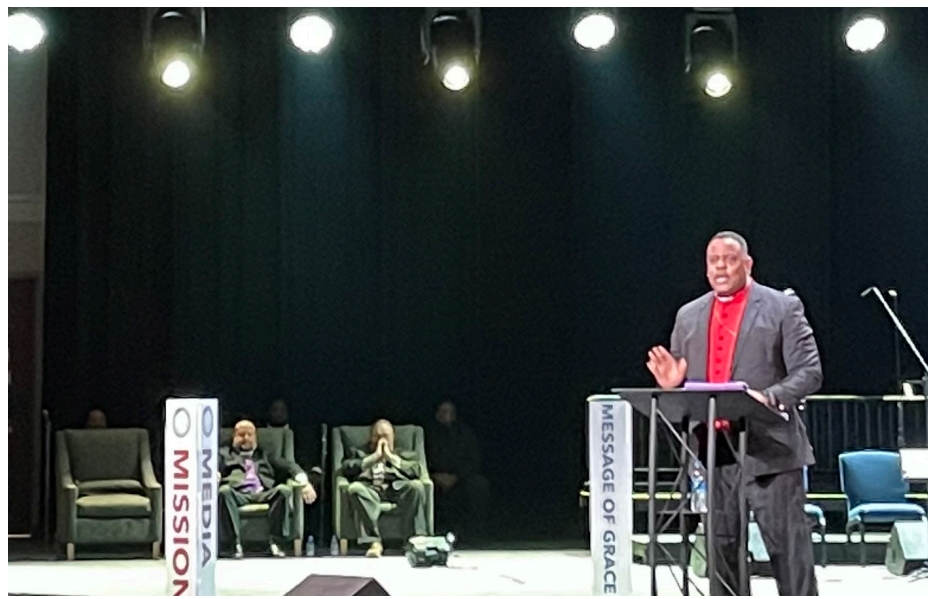
